

**THE 2018 REVIEW OF PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCIES IN WALES –
SECONDARY CONSULTATION PERIOD**

The Commission published all of the responses received during its initial consultation on proposed changes to Parliamentary constituencies in Wales – both written responses and those made orally at public hearings – on 28 February 2017.

The launch sees the start of a statutory four week period during which individuals and organisations will be able to read and comment on the responses that others have made. The consultation will run from **28 February to 27 March 2017**. Any responses received after 28 March will therefore not be considered.
